What is Rotherham Parent Carers Forum?

A registered charity run by and for families of children and young people (aged 0-25) who have Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities (SEND)

We work in partnership with service commissioners and providers, sharing knowledge and experience of families to help plan and develop the quality, range and accessibility of provision, creating better outcomes for families through participation and co-production.

One of the aims of our organisation is that our families should be able to enjoy the same opportunities as any other in terms of health, education, social care and leisure.

Who can join ?

Parent Carers of a child/young person with any type of SEND are welcome to join. What support do we offer ?

Drop in Sessions Every Wednesday (term time) come and join us for a chat at UK Coffee Shop, Parkgate Retail World from 9.30—12noon. There are practitioners in attendance on a rota basis to offer informal advice and support from Educational Psychology, SENDIASS and CAMHS.

Peer support Our team can provide a range of support. We can help you to access services, share strategies to help you support your child and help you to stay positive. We also offer opportunities to make contact with other families in similar situations. Referrals to our peer support service can be made either online or by calling our office

Counselling service A relationship between client and counsellor built on trust and understanding, offering the client a safe and confidential place in which to explore feelings of confusion, dissatisfaction, or distress. A place to look at life's experiences and to explore choices and options for the future.

Strategic Work We have a team of people that work strategically within the local area as well as regionally and nationally to help promote parent and child voice whilst working in co production influencing change.
