 <p>Enhanced Speech and Language Resource</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Specialist Speech and Language support based at Anston Hillcrest Primary School • Y1 – Y5 (Y6 pupils accepted in exceptional circumstances) • Provision usually recommended in partnership with SALT • Up to 12 pupils • At least 4 specialist therapy sessions per week • Access to mainstream school
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New Provision for 2020 (planned opening is still September 2020) • KS2 resource • Up to 10 pupils • Pupils will be educated predominantly in the school and have access to the resource area for interventions and therapies. • All school staff receive AET training
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Specialist Unit for Hearing Impaired Children • FS2 – Y6 (including input in nursery and pre-school) • Provision based on specific level of hearing loss, usually identified and referred through HI team • British Sign Language (BLS) and Sign Supported English (SSE) • Access to mainstream school • Peer education for mainstream school pupils (deaf Awareness)

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New resource for ASD pupils opening Sept 2020 (COVID19 allowing) • Y1-Y6 – up to 10 pupils • Separate classroom and support in mainstream classrooms. • Sensory Room
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New Resource for ASD pupils (build in progress) • Eventual capacity of 25 pupils (increasing gradually over 5 years) • 3 new classrooms, meeting room, sensory room and physio room • Integration into main school and ASD training for staff
